TO: MANUFACTURERS & WHOLESALEERS OF LIQUOR, WINE & BEER

SUBJECT: OVERNIGHT STORAGE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN LICENSED
TRUCKS PARKED IN UNLICENSED GARAGES, IN TRANSIT TO
LICENSED PREMISES.

The State Liquor Authority has recently considered the above matter which was brought to its attention as of real consequence to the industry, largely in connection with merchandise orders, refusals or returns. At its meeting held on April 24-25, 1946, the Authority adopted the following resolution as the basis for an amendment of its existing rules:

"Resolved and Ordered that hereafter a wholesale licensee may, during the course of bona fide deliveries, store its licensed trucks containing alcoholic beverages in an unlicensed garage overnight, provided that no alcoholic beverages other than bona fide orders and returns are so stored."

Kindly note this new ruling and be guided accordingly.
