
TO: WHOLESALERS OF LIQUOR, WINE AND BEER
SUBJECT: SALES TO FORMERLY LICENSED RETAILERS

The State Liquor Authority has been receiving late renewal applications wherein, applicants have revealed that they have been purchasing and selling alcoholic beverages during the period of time they were not licensed.

Please be advised that the State Liquor Authority will take immediate action against the suppliers of alcoholic beverages to retailers, on all late renewals where we find alcoholic beverages have been sold.

All wholesalers are advised to exercise extreme caution as to the purchasers of their products and to instruct their employees that they must ascertain that there is a currently valid license to sell alcoholic beverages on display, in premises, before delivering beverages.
