Question(s) to be considered: Manhattan Community Board #3 recommends disapproval of the Alteration Application which would legalize their already installed stand-up bar, redesigned seating and other alterations to their business stated in their opposition letter.

Protests: Manhattan Community Board #3

Description of Premises: The licensed premises was originally approved on the ground floor of a multi-unit building with interior access to a common hallway through an emergency exit. The front of the premises contained a counter/check out area with food prep and table/counter seating. The rear of the premises contained a small bar area with a straight 12' customer bar and the kitchen.

The proposed/completed alteration to the premises replaced the front counter/check out and food prep area with a 25' L-Shaped customer bar with 11 seats, the table layout of this space was also re-designed creating additional seating. The 12' customer bar was removed creating a larger re-designed dining area in the rear of the premises with additional seating. The licensee has been issued a warehouse permit for storage of alcoholic beverages in a non-contiguous basement which will also contain a separate unlicensed food prep room.
