To: All applicants

Subject: Conditional approvals for applicants with temporary retail permits

Advisory 2019-6 provides that an applicant operating with a temporary retail permit may not obtain an extension of time, beyond the original six months, to comply with the conditions of approval to obtain its license certificate. In Advisory 2020-11, the Members of the Authority granted an exception, allowing a retail applicant operating with a temporary retail permit, for good cause shown, to obtain a six-month extension to satisfy the conditions of approval. Advisory 2020-11 allowed the Licensing Board to grant two such extensions to such an applicant with the Members of the Authority, in their discretion, issuing further extensions.

The provisions of Advisory 2020-11 remained in effect until December 31, 2020 and were not extended by further action of the Members of the Authority. Effective until June 30, 2021, applicants who are operating with a temporary retail permit may request an extension of time, beyond the original six months, to comply with the conditions of approval to obtain its license certificate. However, if the extension is approved, the applicant will not be allowed to continue operating with a temporary retail permit.

This matter was heard and determined by the Members of the Authority at a Full Board meeting held on March 17, 2021 before Chairman Vincent Bradley, Commissioner Lily Fan, and Commissioner Greeley Ford. The above written advisory was approved by the Members of the Authority on March 17, 2021.
