Subject: Collection of civil penalties

Due to the COVID19 public health emergency, the Authority has previously granted temporary relief to licensees by deferring the collection of civil penalties. That temporary relief has been extended by a series of Advisories until July 31, 2021. The deferral of the collection of civil penalties will terminate on July 31, 2021.

Commencing August 1, 2021, the Office of the Secretary to the Authority will resume issuing Notices of Disposition for civil penalties. Licensees, including those whose penalties were deferred, will be given 45 days from the date of the Notice to pay the civil penalty. Failure to timely pay the civil penalty will result in the imposition of the alternate penalty provided for in Advisory 2019-2.

This matter was heard and determined by the Members of the Authority at a Full Board meeting held on July 28, 2021 before Chairman Vincent Bradley, Commissioner Lily Fan and Commissioner Greeley Ford. The above written advisory was approved by the Members of the Authority on July 28, 2021.
