QUESTION(S) TO BE CONSIDERED: Is there good cause to deny this application? Is the funding source a loan or an equity interest?

The applicant received \$50,900 of their \$66,650 funding through a fundraising platform campaign called Mainvest. Mainvest states on their website that they are a licensed Funding Portal that offers investments under Regulation Crowdfunding, which is also known as Title III Crowdfunding. The applicant received 96 investors with an average investment of \$530. The applicant must now repay the investors 1.5% of revenue generated every quarter with the total amount owed of \$66,260 due by October 1, 2028. In order to send investors repayments, the applicant must enter in their quarterly revenue amount (3/31, 6/30, 9/30, 12/31) and approve the withdrawal from their bank account. Mainvest will then process the payments to every investor.

The applicant submitted a copy of an Investment Agreement, an Investor Information Sheet, a Revenue Sharing Note, a Revenue Sharing Agreement, and list of all their investor's names and how much they invested.

Description of Premises: Premises is located on the ground floor and basement of a multi-unit commercial and residential building. The ground floor consists of a dining area, customer bar, kitchen, and two (2) restrooms. The basement consists of storage and an office area. Maximum Occupancy is 74. There are 9 tables with a total of 18 seats and a customer bar that seats 8. There will be a sidewalk café licensed that has an outside capacity of 12 and is delineated by fencing.

- The ALJ conducting the 500 Foot Hearing determined that the applicant had not demonstrated that issuance of the license would be in the public interest.
- There is a discrepancy between with the days and hours of operation listed on the Community Board Conditions and the submitted Public Interest Questionnaire. The Community Board Conditions indicate a closing time at 10:00 pm Sunday through Thursday while the Public Interest Questionnaire indicates a 2:00 am closing time on those days. For Friday and Saturday, The Community Board Conditions indicate a 1:00 am closing time, compared to a 2:00 am closing time indicated in the Public Questionnaire.
- Applicant has not provided sufficient information to determine as to whether the proposed licensed premises would have an impact on vehicle or pedestrian traffic in the area.
- There are residents living above and/or adjacent to the proposed licensed premises and the applicant did not indicate whether the residents support or oppose the application. Also, applicant does not provide any information about which residents were contacted, how the residents were contacted or what information the residents were provided.
