**QUESTION(S) TO BE CONSIDERED:** Is there good cause to deny this application?

Two prior applications for this premises were disapproved. Atit Jariwala was a principal on both prior applications, and he is a principal under co-licensee Bridgeton Hotel Management, LLC on the present application.

The first application was filed on 05/01/2020 by Montauk Atlantic Terrace Hotel Operating Group, LLC; Bridgeton Hotel Management LLC; and IL Buco Corp, Serial # Suffolk HL 1328088. It was disapproved by the Members of the Authority on 12/08/2020. The application received strong opposition from the community and town officials. The applicant was operating outside the Certificate of Occupancy for this location.

The second application, Montauk Atlantic Terrace Hotel Operating Group LLC & Bridgeton Hotel Management LLC, Serial # Suffolk HL 1338345 was filed on 08/27/2021 and approved by the Members of the Authority on 05/11/2022. The application was eventually disapproved on 01/24/2023 for failure to comply with submitting the conditions of approval.

The applicant intends to license the beach area, which the Authority would require to be contained in some way. Per the protest letter on file from Cheryl Richer, town code does not allow for beaches to be cordoned off. How does the applicant intend to license the beach?

**Description of Premises:** Hotel with (4) two story buildings, providing (96) rooms, and (2) outdoor customer bars.

Building one consists of a basement level with storage areas, (2) restrooms, 2 hotel guest common area. First floor consists of a lounge area, lobby, and guest rooms. The second floor consists of guest rooms. Total guest rooms in building one is 42.

Building two consists of first and second floors with multiple guest rooms. Total guestrooms in building two are 12.

Building three consists of a basement, 2 restrooms, with a common area and staff housing. Floors one and two contain guestrooms. Total guestrooms in building three are 14, plus two rooms for staff.

Building four consists of a basement with a restaurant with multiple tables and seats, kitchen, storage areas, utility room, and laundry room. The first and second floors have multiple guest rooms. The total guestrooms from building four is 28.

Outdoor areas consist of patio areas, decks, (2) customer bar areas, a pool, beach and garden.

**Method of Operation:** Hotel with restaurant and sixty-seven employees. The applicant will hire a manager. The establishment will provide recorded music only.

This is the applicant's third attempt at obtaining a license at this location.

- The first application, Westchester OP 1335077 was applied for under 53 Park Hill Avenue (same location - a/k/a address) and was disapproved for not disclosing that St. Gregorios Orthodox Church was located within 200' of the proposed premises. An SLA Beverage Control Investigator (BCI) measured a distance of 166.81'. Reconsideration was requested and denied.
- A second application was filed under Westchester OP 1339572, at 188 Waverly St (same location) and was disapproved due to the Standardized Notification to the Municipality being over 270-days old. Reconsideration was granted. In this application to avoid the 200' law the applicant decided to use a different entrance for ingress/egress. A BCI remeasured to the new door and found the distance to be 192.57'. The application was disapproved again for being within 200' of a church.
- The applicant has now applied for a restaurant wine license

**Description of Premises:** Premises is located on the first floor and basement of a 2-story, multi-unit building. The maximum proposed occupancy is 140. The first floor will consist of a dining area with 16 tables and 64 seats, a customer bar with 12 seats, two restrooms, a kitchen, an office, and a storage/additional food prep area.
